Aims:

- To minimise the effect on the environment locally, regionally and globally
- To reduce the amount of waste produced during the construction process
- To regularly brief the workforce about environment issues
- Where waste is unavoidable to send the majority for recycling
- To use sustainable resources where there is an option available.

Strategies:

- Ensure that all staff are trained with the environmental policy in mind
- To strive to continue improvements in environmental performance and the prevention of pollution
- To set minimum standards taking into account environmental regulations, laws and codes of practice
- We will endeavour to dispose of all waste in a responsible manner ie the yard has recycling skips
- Where possible use green transport including cycling to work, lift shares where possible or to use public transport
- Attempt to reduce or eliminate the use of ozone depleting chemicals (CFC, Halon, 1.1.1 Trichloroethane, HCFC), tropical hard wood from forests which have not been independently certified as sustainable, pesticides on the U.K. 'red list' of EC 'black list' and peat for soil amelioration purposes
- Try and use suppliers who are willing to remove all packaging to re-cycle or re-use
- Try to use sub-contractors and suppliers who comply without environment policy
- Monitor the environment policy and view to improve our performance year on year
